Grant Title: Zoo Field Trip Subject: Science Grade: 1 Number of Students Impacted: 60

GOAL(S) of the project are stated.

Project Purpose:

The purpose of my grant request is to take our school's first graders on a FUN field trip to the Naples Zoo to learn about animals and plants. To be able to help students build background knowledge and experiences through visiting a zoo, funding is needed for the zoo admission and transportation costs.

The project is a zoo field trip. The students learn about plants and animals in our science curriculum, so what better way to learn than through a hands-on field trip.

BUDGET

Item 2: 4 additional chaperones @ \$23 (\$92)

Item 3: CCPS Bus transportation- 2 buses (\$200)
