**About the Opportunity:** Get a glimpse inside Collier County's classrooms! Grant proposals are open to teachers from all public, charter, and independent schools. The committee is a selected group of individuals who read, review, and score submitted grants. Grants range from \$100-\$2,000 and are can target any subject or grade level.

**The Volunteer Role:** The committee gathers for a kick-off meeting where you'll receive "Round 1" of grant proposals, as well as the rubric and guidelines for scoring. Grants are also available for online review. You may read as many rounds as desired. The committee will meet at the end of Round 3 to review scores and allocation of funds.
