## Conversation Leaders

**About the Opportunity:** Through Community Roundtables, administrators, parents, students, and business people gather to learn about key education issues in our community. These are hosted 1-2x/year, in a respectful and inclusive format within small groups. Roundtables allow us to learn from one another, build a deeper sense of community, and help us all work towards similar goals.

**The Volunteer Role:** Community Roundtables are intentionally crafted to foster an engaging, inclusive conversation. This format requires one Conversation Leader per table. They receive training prior to the event, including standards for an inclusive conversation, along with a conversation guide.
